

- 6. Animal Health:
 - a. All cattle have been dewormed and vaccinated for IBR, PI-3, BVD, Lepto, and Vibrio.
 - b. All horses have been dewormed and vaccinated for Eastern and Western Equine Encephalomyelitis, West Nile Virus, Tetanus, Influenza, and Rhinopneumonitis and have a current negative Coggins Test.
 - c. The Louisiana Tech beef herd is certified Brucelloisis-free (Herd #89-816).
 - d. Health certificates for interstate travel and other appropriate documents will be provided on each animal.
- 7. Registration certificates for registered animals will be available to buyers at check out.
- 8. Females sold as "exposed" are not guaranteed to be pregnant.
- 9. All persons who attend the sale do so at their own risk.
