- 2. Scholarship(s) will be awarded annually, with disbursement quarterly.
- 3. Scholarship(s) shall be awarded to a student pursuing a master of science degree in the in the School of Biological Sciences (M.S. in Biology or M.S. in MNST) or a PhD in MSNT, under the supervision of a faculty member in the School of Biological Sciences.
- 4. The recipient must be passionate about receiving a graduate degree that will prepare him/her for a successful career in a field related to or identified with biology.
- 5. The scholarship shall be intended to assist the recipient(s) in paying any college education costs that would otherwise be paid to Louisiana Tech University by the student.
- 6. The scholarship recipient must submit a letter of recommendation from a faculty advisor and maintain enrollment in an appropriate Graduate Program.
- 7. The student must be registered as a full-time graduate student each quarter to receive the scholarship, that is a minimum of 6 hours of graduate credit each quarter.
