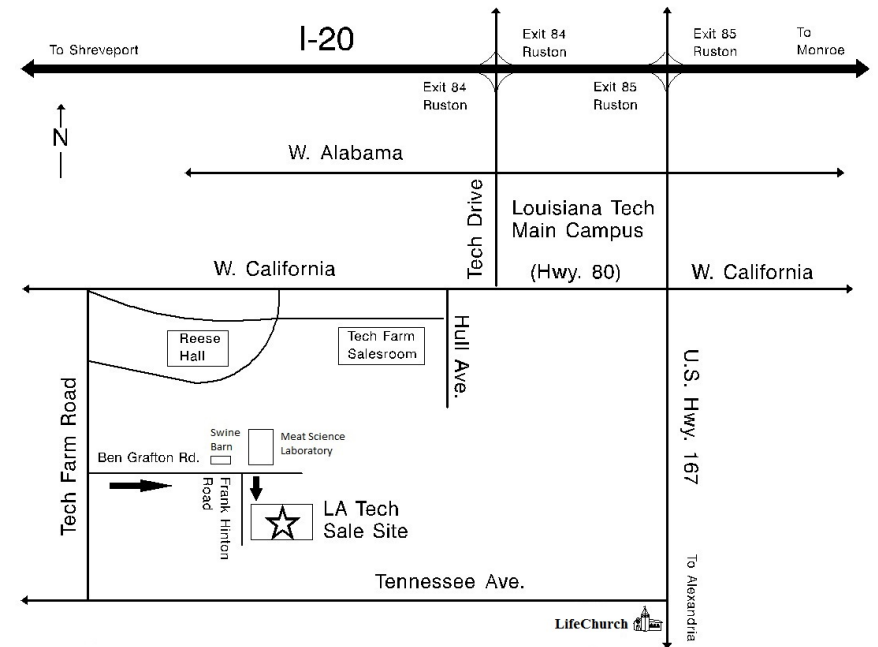

6. Animal Health:
  - a. All cattle have been dewormed and vaccinated for IBR, PI-3, BVD, Lepto, and Vibrio.
  - b. Health certificates for interstate travel and other appropriate documents will be provided for each animal, as needed.
7. Females sold as "exposed" are not guaranteed to be pregnant.
8. All persons who attend the sale do so at their own risk.

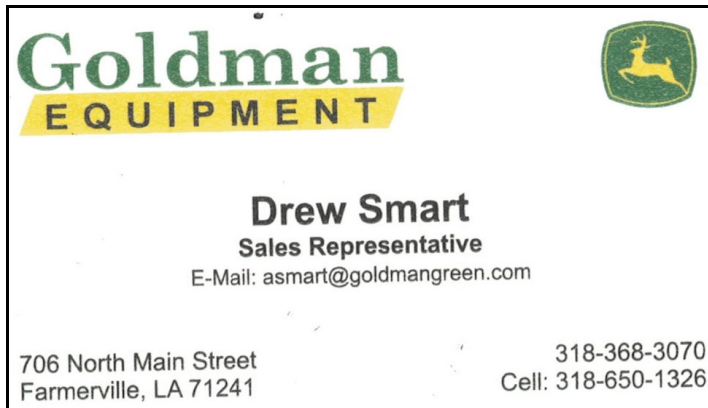
